

Pregabalin Cap	Lyrica®	Neuropathic pain associated with diabetic neuropathy, fibromyalgia, adjunct therapy for partial onset seizures, postherpetic neuralgia (PHN), neuropathic pain associated with spinal cord injury
Topiramate Tab	Topamax®	Epilepsy with partial onset or primary generalized tonic-clonic seizures; migraine prophylaxis, and adjunct therapy for patients with seizures associated with Lennox-Gastaut syndrome



Baclofen Tab	Lioresal®	Spasticity from multiple sclerosis (particularly for the relief of flexor spasms), spinal cord injury, and other spinal cord diseases injury and other spinal cord diseases
Carisoprodol Tab	Soma®	Relief of discomfort associated with acute, painful musculoskeletal conditions (up to 2-3 weeks)
Cyclobenzaprine HCl Tab	Flexeril®	Adjunct therapy for muscle spasm associated with acute, painful musculoskeletal conditions (up to 2-3 weeks). Not effective in the treatment of spasticity or cerebral palsy
Metaxalone Tab	Skelaxin®	Adjunct therapy for discomforts associated with acute, painful musculoskeletal conditions
Methocarbamol Tab	Robaxin®	Adjunct therapy for discomforts associated with acute, painful musculoskeletal conditions
Tizanidine HCl Cap or Tab	Zanaflex®	For the short-term relief of spasticity, reserved for daily activities and times when the relief of spasticity is most important

Buprenorphine Patch Weekly	Butrans®	Management of severe pain that requires daily, around-the-clock (ATC), long-term opioid treatment for which alternative treatment options are inadequate
Fentanyl Patch 72 Hour	Duragesic®	Persistent, moderate to severe chronic pain in opioid-tolerant patients, that requires continuous, around-the-clock (ATC) opioid administration for an extended period of time and can't be managed by other means such as non-steroidal analgesics, opioid combination products or immediate-release opioids
Hydrocodone- Acetaminophen Tab	Lortab® Norco® Vicodin®	For the treatment of moderate to severe pain when alternative treatments are inadequate

Diclofenac Sodium Gel	Voltaren*	For the relief of the pain of osteoarthritis of joints amenable to topical treatment, such as the knees and those of the hands
Diclofenac Sodium Solution	Pennsaid®	Treatment of signs and symptoms of osteoarthritis (OA) of the knee
Lidocaine Ointment and Cream*	Xylocaine®	Relief of pain associated with postherpetic neuralgia (PHN) and temporary relief of pain associated with minor burns and abrasions of the skin

Psychiatric Medications

Medications to treat mood or behavior disorders, including anti-depressants, anti-anxiety medications, and drugs to help with mental alertness

Psychiatric Medications can include:

- ▶ Anti-anxiety drugs
- ▶ Anti-depressants
- ▶ Certain psychiatric medications may also be used for neuropathic and chronic pain
